Born in 1959 in Lviv, Ukraine.

In 1981, graduated with honours from the Lviv National Academy of Applied and Decorative Arts. Commenced his work at the Sculpture Department of the Lviv's College of Applied Arts named after Ivan Trush (1982-1992).

Since 1992 lives and creates in Canada.

Works in sculpture (compositions, figurative, portraits, architectural), monumental sculpture, painting, murals, restoration and gilding.

Since 1980 has been a participant in numerous group exhibits in Ukraine, Russia, Italy, USA and Canada. Had three solo exhibitions in Toronto, Canada in 1994 and 1999. Organized and participated in three symposiums in wood sculpture in 1999 – 2001.

Created several monuments, monumental signs, park sculptures and memorial plaques in Ukraine, USA, Canada, France and Great Britain.

Earned numerous awards and grants. Among them, in 2006, received a Monument Builders of North America Civic/Public Award for the Monument in Rochester, NY, commemorating the 100th Anniversary of the Ukrainian Settlement.

President of the Ukrainian Association of Visual Artists of Canada, Art Committee Chair of the Ukrainian Canadian Art Foundation, member of the National Artist's Union of Ukraine and the Sculptor's Society of Canada.
